We devote our best efforts in providing supportive services to Veterans. VETcare's VA Grant Per Diem (GPD) transitional program provides safe and supportive, gender-responsive, and trauma-informed services to male Veterans experiencing homelessness. The goal of this program is to increase skill levels, income, and self-sufficiency as the Veterans that we serve prepare to transition into permanent housing. Mental health counseling, life skills training, substance abuse treatment, and case management services are provided to Veterans to remove past or future housing stability barriers. VETcare provides six months of GPD case management where our goal is to improve the retention of housing by Veterans who were previously homeless and are transitioning into permanent housing from programs such as GPD or the VA's Healthcare for Homeless Veterans (HCHV) Contracted Residential Services (CRS) program. Case management includes but is not limited to making home visits to monitor housing stability and providing referrals to needed services pertaining to mental health, substance use disorders, medical care, and employment assistance. Our Homeless Veterans Reintegration Program (HVRP) services are available to assist homeless Veterans with reintegration and employment while our Staff Sergeant Parker Gordon Fox Suicide Prevention Grant (SSG Fox) program, VETcare Prevents, provides community-based suicide prevention efforts to meet the needs of Veterans and their families through outreach and connections to VA benefits and other community resources.
